SIENA FUN RUN: TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By participating in the Event participants will be deemed to have read, understood and accepted the Terms and Conditions of Entry. Where a participant is under 18 years of age a parent or guardian must read the Terms and Conditions of Entry and accept them on their behalf.

1. I, the primary registrant for all participants named in this registration form (known hereafter as I/we), do hereby waive all and any rights, claims or cause of action which may arise from loss, damage or injury which may be sustained in the course of or arising out of my entry in the 2024 Siena College Fun Run.
2. I certify that all participants named in this registration form under the age of 18, have consent from their parent/legal guardian to participate in the Siena Fun Run.
3. I/we agree that all participating children aged 3 to 11 years will be accompanied by a parent/guardian/adult supervisor over 18 years, who must also register as a participant in the event.
4. I/we agree to be bound by the official rules and regulations of this event.
5. I/we agree that in the event of cancellation of the Fun Run Event by Siena College due to temperature, rain, weather, winds, storms, other 'Acts of God' conditions, or unforeseen circumstances, a partial refund of the registration fee will be made, less any booking fee applied.
6. I/we agree that in the event of registration cancellation by a participant, no refund will be given within one week (7 days) of the event. Cancellations outside this 7 day window will be refunded in full, less any booking fee applied.
7. I/we hereby acknowledge that all participants/spectators have sole responsibility for their own personal possessions and equipment during the event and its related activities. Siena College or any other sponsor of the event, or any of their agents and servants, shall have no liability for any loss or damage occurring to any items of clothing, footwear, jewellery, or other personal effects, including those placed in the custody of the College by competitors in relation to the conducting of this event.
8. I/we acknowledge that medical advice should be sought prior to participation in the event if any participant named in this registration form has suffered or is suffering from any medical condition. I/we hereby consent to receive, at my/our expense, medical treatment including ambulance, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and/or illness during the event.
9. I/we acknowledge the right of the event organisers to use photographs taken at the event for their use in promotional communications and other purposes for current and future events without my further consent being obtained.

Event Rules

- The Siena Fun Run is a friendly running and walking competition hosted by Siena College, Camberwell.
- The race takes place at Wattle Park, Burwood.
- 4km: minimum age is 7 years old on race day.
- Colour Run: minimum age is 3 years old on race day.
- All participants aged 11 years and under, must be accompanied by a parent/guardian/adult over 18 years.
- All participants under 18 years of age must have consent from their Parent/Guardian to participate.
- All participants must be registered via the online booking system.
- Entry fees are not refundable, unless the event is cancelled by Siena College Camberwell, in which case a partial or full refund will be applied.
- Participant bibs will be utilised for both events at the Fun Run and distributed to participants during check-in on race day. The bib must be securely attached to the front of t-shirt/singlet attire for the duration of the race event. Race times will only be recorded for the 4km timed race event.
- The start time of the 4km event is 5.30pm and the end time for this event is 6.25pm. The start time of the Colour Run event is 6.15pm and the end time is 7.30pm. If you do not complete the event within the allocated time, you will be listed as 'Did Not Finish' and, for the 4km event, no time will be recorded.
- All participants must stay on the defined course as any departure may lead to disqualification.
- Lost property can be taken to the Registration desk. At the end of the event lost items will be taken to Siena College. All lost property will be kept for a minimum of two weeks at Siena College before it is donated to charity.
- Pets, rollerblades, skates, scooters, skateboards and bikes are not allowed.
- First aid stations are located at the Start/Finish area on the Wattle Park Oval.
- On course and finish line water stations are available, and food and drinks will be available for purchase.
- Toilets are located on the site and will be marked on the race maps provided.
- All decisions made by the Race Director are final.

SIENA FUN RUN: COLOUR POWDER WARNING

For those joining in the Colour Fun Run, please note:

- The colour is coloured cornstarch, non toxic and environmentally friendly.
- The cornstarch is very fine, so please wear goggles or sunglasses and/or a disposable mask if concerned.
- Wearing of contact lenses is not recommended.
- Wear old (light in colour) clothes.
- Wrap your phone in a zip lock bag, glad wrap it or don't take it on the run.
- Blondes are very susceptible to getting coloured hair... rub some olive/coconut oil or conditioner into your hair before the run
- Remember your trip home. Bring some large plastic garbage/garden bags to cover your seats, old towels, or bring a change of clothes.
- We cannot take any responsibility for any costs associated for colour removal from you or your clothes.
